- ☼ Located at Bramlett and University Ave.
- ☼ ~1/3 acre enclosed by an 8' fence
- ☼ 41 individual plots (4'x8', 10'x16', and 16'x16')
- ☼ 4 Community Harvest plots + blueberries
- ☼ 9 children's plots (3' x 3')
- ☼ Communal areas
- ☼ 7 water faucets
- ☼ Shed/tools/compost bins





Some ways to share in the OCGA fun:

- ☼ Garden in a Community Harvest plot as an individual or with your group (produce donated to charity).
- ☼ Grow in your own plot (*only children's plots are still available for 2011, but we maintain a wait list*).
- ☼ Help landscape or maintain communal areas.
- ☼ Attend a gardening workshop.
- ☼ Mentor beginning gardeners.
- ☼ Build something for us (e.g., benches, tables, produce washing station...).
- ☼ Create garden art.
- ☼ Donate supplies, tools, compost, organizational skills, time, or money.
